from "A Method to Reconstruct Families in Recke - Westphalen" by Max Schulte:

"Since a feudal system was in use, people were either free or owned by the King, the Church, a monastery or a local landlord. In a system like this the farmer exploiting a farm was called a colon and was referred to by the farm name. The right to use the farm could be transferred to one of the children. If this was a girl and she got married, her husband would take the name of the farm, i.e. her name. If the woman died, the new colon would remarry and start a new family-lineage using the farmname, without any genetic link to the former colon-family, though sharing the same name in records."

"Since a feudal system was in use, people were either free or owned by the King, the Church, a monastery or a local landlord. In a system like this the farmer exploiting a farm was called a colon and was referred to by the farm name. The right to use the farm could be transferred to one of the children. If this was a girl and she got married, her husband would take the name of the farm, i.e. her name. If the woman died, the new colon would remarry and start a new family-lineage using the farmname, without any genetic link to the former colon-family, though sharing the same name in records."
