Died.--On the 12th inst. at Jeffersonville, In., of Consumption, Mr. WELLINGTON B. PIERCE, age 35 years. Mr. Pierce was for a long time a resident of this place, and had gained many friends. At the time of his death, he was Book Keeper to the Indiana State Prison. He died in the triumphs of faith, his last words being "all is well."

NOTE:

This couple was said to have 3 children. I can only find one, even in the 1850 census! They both died early and rumor is the children were raised by the MORGAN Family. Searching for any proof! Lyman does NOT appear anywhere in the 1860 census but may have been in the army at that time.

LYMAN PIERCE

DIES RATHER SUDDENLY AT HIS
HOME IN THIS CITY

He Was Aged Sixty-five and Had
Been Deputy Sheriff and Chief
Of Police

Lyman Pierce, one of the best-known citizens of Owensboro, died of apoplexy at 5 o'clock Tuesday afternoon at his home at 932 Leitchfield road. He had been ill but a short time and his death was entirely unexpected. Mr. Pierce had always been apparently a hearty and healthy man.

Mr. Pierce was sixty-five years of age and was born at Rockport, Ind., August 21, 1844. He had been a resident of Owensboro for many years and was engaged in the grocery business several times. For eight years he was a deputy sheriff of Daviess county and for four years he was chief of police of the city. He was a Confederate veteran and was a member of the Rice E. Graves camp of Owensboro. A meeting of the camp has been called for 3 o'clock this afternoon to arrange for the camp attending the funeral in a body.

He is survived by five sons and one daughter. His wife died several years ago. The children surviving are: L.E.; L. H.; H. W.; F. M.; W. D. Pierce and Mrs. P. J. McArdle.

The funeral will take place at 10 o'clock Thursday morning from the residence with services by the Rev. J. H. Young, of Settle Memorial church, of which the deceased was a member. The interment will be in the Iron Ore Hill cemetery.
